COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Accept proposal for Preliminary Engineering Services

HISTORY, FACTS, AND ISSUES: The Lowndes County Engineering Department has requested a proposal from Guess and Lovell Surveying and Mapping for preliminary engineering services for Exit 22 and 29 utility relocations. As a part of the Exit 22 and 29 interchange project, each individual property owner is responsible for preliminary engineering drawings, final construction plans as a part of the GDOT construction plans, and cost for relocations. This proposal is for the preliminary engineering only as the extent of the final construction documents cannot be determined until preliminary engineering is complete. The preliminary engineering services will include:

Vertical and Horizontal alignments of water and sewer lines, manholes, valves, hydrants, etc.
Base Map in MicroStation format for GDOT Approval
Development of Plan and Profile of existing utilities
Meeting with GDOT and Identification of potential conflicts due to improvements


