HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: On January 10, 2017, the Lowndes County Board of Commissioners determined the highway-rail at-grade crossing on Dasher Johnson Road has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that its removal from the county road system is otherwise in the best public interest. As required by Georgia statute, each adjoining property owner was notified by certified mail of the intent and public hearing. The public hearing was also advertised in the *Valdosta Daily Times*.
