HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: During the 2015 legislative session, the General Assembly passed HB 192 which changed the requirements for county issued purchasing cards and credit cards used by elected officials. In February of 2016, the County adopted an ordinance outlining the card program as required by the statute. Additionally, each elected official using a card was required to be approved in an open meeting after signing a credit card user agreement. As the newly elected Tax Commissioner, Rodney Cain is requesting approval to be issued a county purchasing card and has signed the required agreement.
