HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES:

Per guidance from the Southern Georgia Regional Commission (SGRC), staff is seeking support and/or guidance from the LCBOC related to the FY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application. Lowndes County is currently on course to apply for \$750,000.00 in CDBG funds from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for a new public facility for the Valdosta-Lowndes County Habitat for Humanity. Habitat for Humanity has committed to leverage cash funds for this project. The items recommended for LCBOC consideration are the following:

1. Issue a public declaration of “No Conflict of Interest” by any elected official or county staff through approval of the attached certification
2. Approval of the Attached Resolution
3. Authorize Applicable County Officials to Sign and Execute Grant Documents (Chairman, Vice-Chair, County Manager, County Clerk, etc.)

Unless a conflict is identified from an Elected Official or County Staff that is not currently known, staff’s recommendation is for the LCBOC to approve Item #1 above (The “No Conflict of Interest” certification), to approve Item #2 above (Resolution), and to authorize Item #3 above (Signatures).
