COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Bid for Custom Cab Fire Pumper

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: Lowndes County solicited bids for a new model year, custom cab fire pumper for the Fire Department. This pumper will replace a 2012 Ferrara pumper that currently has approximately 89,000 miles and chronic service issues. The 2012 pumper will be moved into reserve status and will be used as a replacement when other equipment is down. It will also provide additional credits in the County's next Insurance Services Organization (ISO) evaluation.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting was conducted to answer any questions that potential bidders may have. Two vendors attended and subsequently submitted sealed bids; however, one was deemed as non-responsive. The sole responsive bidder provided two payment options for the new apparatus.

Ten-8 Fire Equipment, Inc. – (1) Pierce Custom Pumper on Saber Chassis

Option 1: Payment at delivery \$498,985.00

Option 2: Payment upon order \$475,679.00 includes 100% performance bond


