HISTORY, FACTS, AND ISSUES: On February 10, the Lowndes County Board of Commissioners accepted a proposal from Guess and Lovell for preliminary engineering services for the referenced project. Preliminary Engineering is complete, therefore the Lowndes County Engineering Department has requested a proposal from Lovell Engineering for professional engineering services for Exit 22 and 29 utility relocations. As a part of the Exit 22 and 29 interchange project, each individual property owner is responsible for preliminary engineering drawings, final construction plans as a part of the GDOT construction plans, and cost for relocations. This proposal is for the engineering only as the preliminary engineering is now complete.


