COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Intrado Phone System Upgrade Agreement

HISTORY, FACTS, AND ISSUES: At the August 14, 2018, Lowndes County Board of Commissioners regular session meeting, the Commission approved a proposal from AT&T for the Intrado phone system upgrade in the amount of \$244,342.00. The follow-up agreement is attached.

The Intrado phone system, serviced and provided by AT&T, needs to be upgraded in order to meet vendor specifications for E911 services. The cost quoted from AT&T is \$244,342.00, financed for 60 months at \$4,605.00, per month. This will include all new servers and hardware to outfit 12 console positions, as well as software and installation.


