COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: FY2018 Performance Partnership Agreement and EMPG Application

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: Each year, as a condition of receiving Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) funding, the Georgia Emergency Management Agency (GEMA) requires local agencies to enter into a partnership agreement. This agreement requires that the Board of Commissioners, the local Emergency Management Agency, and the Director agree to meet the requirements outlined in the Georgia Emergency Management Act of 1981, the Federal Emergency Management Agency Guidance for FY2018 EMPG funding, and reporting and other requirements outlined by the Director of GEMA/Office of Homeland Security. Funding amounts are based on population using the 2010 Census data. Lowndes County currently receives \$32,770 annually as part of this agreement.

For their part, GEMA agrees to provide resource and, when available, funding support to local governments both during times of disaster and in the performance of planning, training, and other administrative duties when no disasters are occurring.


