COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Abandonment of a portion of Beaver Lane

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The County has received a request to abandon a portion of Beaver Lane (CR 259), from its intersection with Phillips Road to its intersection with Mt Zion Road, the entire length being 0.18 miles long and is shown on the attached drawing. Georgia statute requires an initial determination that the "section of the county road system has for any reason ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it or that its removal from the county road system is otherwise in the best public interest." If the Board makes either or both of these determinations with respect to Beaver Lane, the statute provides for notice to adjoining property owners, notice to the public by newspaper publication, and a public hearing. After the public hearing, the Board "may declare that section of the county road system abandoned."


