COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Continued environmental services for the former Wisenbaker/Amoco Service Station

HISTORY, FACTS, AND ISSUES: The former Wisenbaker/Amoco Service Station is located directly behind the Administration Building at 327 N. Ashley St. The site has been up and running since 2007. Lowndes County has to report quarterly and semi-annually to the Georgia EPD and the system has to be maintained on an on-going basis. AECOM installed the system, monitored the system and has completed all the reports since installation. The plume has diminished significantly, but there is still product in the ground. Staff and AECOM cannot give an exact time frame on when Georgia EPD will allow the system to come offline, but staff estimates the system will need to run for at least 3 more years. As reporting is done in the coming year, staff and AECOM will meet with the Georgia EPD regarding future monitoring requirements.
