COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Public use on county Right of Way

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The County has received a request to abandon the unopened right of way off of Pikes Pond Road. The right of way has never been opened or maintained by Lowndes County. Georgia statute requires an initial determination that the "section of the county road system has for any reason ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it or that its removal from the county road system is otherwise in the best public interest." If the Board makes this determination with respect to the unopened Right of Way, the statute provides for notice to adjoining property owners, notice to the public by newspaper publication, and a public hearing. After the public hearing, the Board "may declare that section of the county road system abandoned."


