ANNOUNCES OFFICE CLOSURE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

Lowndes County, GA – In light of recent developments with the spread of the COVID-19 virus and rapidly changing protocols as issued by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and in light of states of emergency having been declared by the President of the United States and the Governor of the State of Georgia, the **Lowndes County Tax Commissioner’s Office and Drive Thru will be closed to the public effective March 24, 2020, until further notice.**

Commissioner Cain states, “We remain dedicated to serving the public during this period of time.
